Scripture. Selection 688 in Signal

Text: Zech. 9:9.

Sub: Time of Passover feast. Great
crowds in Jerusalem, etc.

I. Triumphal Entry not an
Accident. -

1. Planned by Jesus ^{Kingship}
2. To proclaim his ^{Kingship} messianicship.
3. To provide pretext for his enemies
to take him.

II. Day Chosen was significant.

1. Fourth day of feast. Day on
which Paschal lamb was
chosen. He therefore placed
himself on altar of sacrifice.
"He became Paschal lamb, by
God appointed, and all our
sins on him were laid."

2. Recognition was evidence of
divine approval and seal
of his royal claims, and
sure token that hour of
his messianic sacrifice

was at hand.

2. Possession of temple.

Manner of Entry suggested
Lowliness.

"I am meek and lowly
in heart" - Matt 11: 29.

1. Cleansing of temple

on Jerusalem -

matter - no books or religious
magazines.
