I Reasons for Flood

1. Wickedness of men.

Verse 5. - Every imagination of heart was only evil continually. - no mixture of good, no repentance, no hesitation, no debating. - A world

of fierce men - violent, law-
less. no encouragement
to righteous living.

Cause of this wickedness
was marriages of sons of
God & daughters of men.
Sons of God sank to level
of daughters of men.

Reputed God, grieved
him at hearts.

of all ancient nations.
2. Destroyed all, ex-
cept Noah.
