

"Some Grounds for Assurance"

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Scripture Lesson:-

Text:-

Sub:- The old Testament worshipped  
came often bringing his sacrifice. He never  
seemed to have an assurance of his  
acceptance of God. He came again  
and again bringing his sacrifice for sin.  
Jesus once and for all time made the  
sacrifice for sin. When we accept by  
faith the sacrifice he made for us  
we need bring no sacrifice for sin.

Thus the Church has had an ad-  
euphatic message of salvation. It had  
been able to say to men, that salvation  
is present. That is what men wanted  
"a present salvation".

Salvation is a subjective experience.  
It has external manifestations. There  
is no salvation from sin, from the  
inward condemnation of sin, without  
cessation from outward sins. An inner  
spiritual transformation results in  
an outward moral renovation.

I. No Condemnation.

1. Rom 8:1.

1. note - no condemnation to  
them in Christ Jesus. -
2. who walk not after flesh.

One know that we have passed from death to life. because we love the brethren.

## V. Final salvation dependant on Our Faithfulness.

1. Col 1:23. "If ye continue in the faith."
